A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING THE VILLAGE OF LEROY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE AS A TYPE I ACTION, NOMINATING THE VILLAGE OF LEROY AS THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW LEAD AGENCY, AND NOTIFYING INVOLVED AND INTERESTED AGENCIES PURSUANT TO 6 NYCRR PART 617

WHEREAS, the Village of LeRoy has proposed undertaking an update to their Comprehensive Plan to align the vision of the future with the goals and needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Village of LeRoy has reviewed the project and has concluded that the projects are subject to requirements of 6 NYCRR, Part 617;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of LeRoy hereby concludes that the Project is a Type I Action subject to the review requirements specified in 6 NYCRR, Part 617; and



RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE ENVIRONMENTAL SIGNIFICANCE OF REVISING THE VILLAGE OF LEROY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village of LeRoy has prepared a revision to the Village of LeRoy Comprehensive Plan in accordance with General City Law §28-a (aka "The Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Village of LeRoy has reviewed the attached Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) for the proposed project, has identified the relevant areas of environmental concern, and has taken a hard look at these areas of concern; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the information recorded on the EAF and in consideration of the criteria for determining significance as set forth in NYCRR 617.7(c), the Village of LeRoy has reasonably determined that the proposed project will not result in a significant adverse environmental impact.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of LeRoy that a SEQR Negative Declaration shall be filed in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act.
