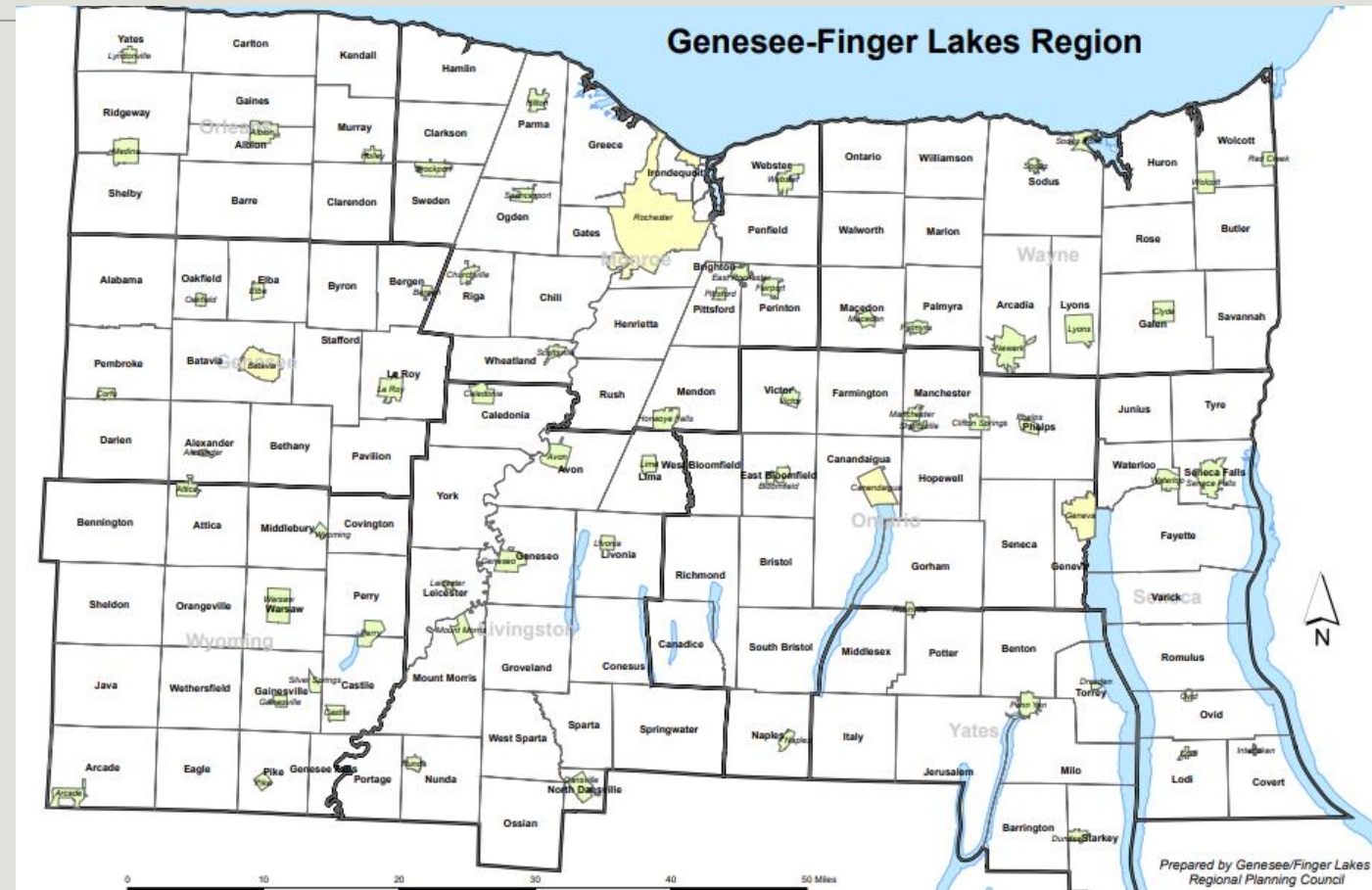

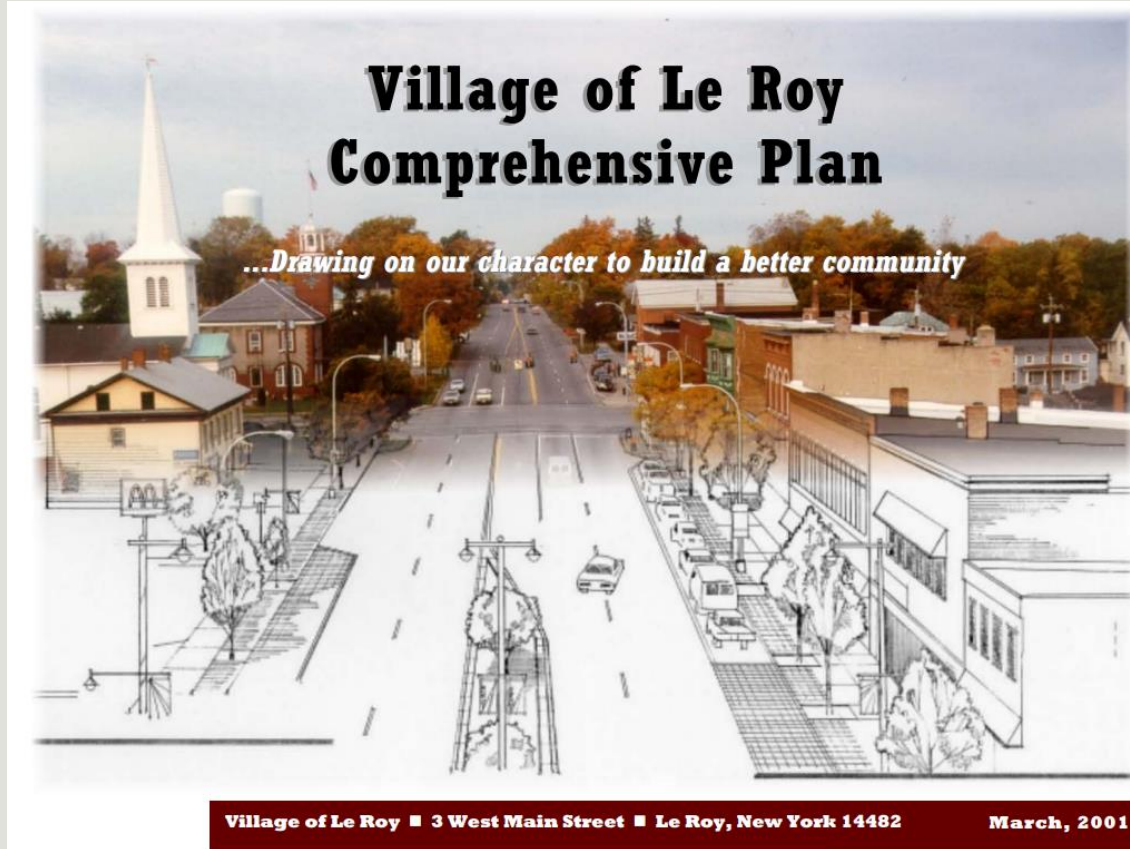

- Short-term and long-term actions.
- Informed by community input and feedback.
- Helps inform key governmental functions.
- Requires strong leadership and commitment to be implemented.
